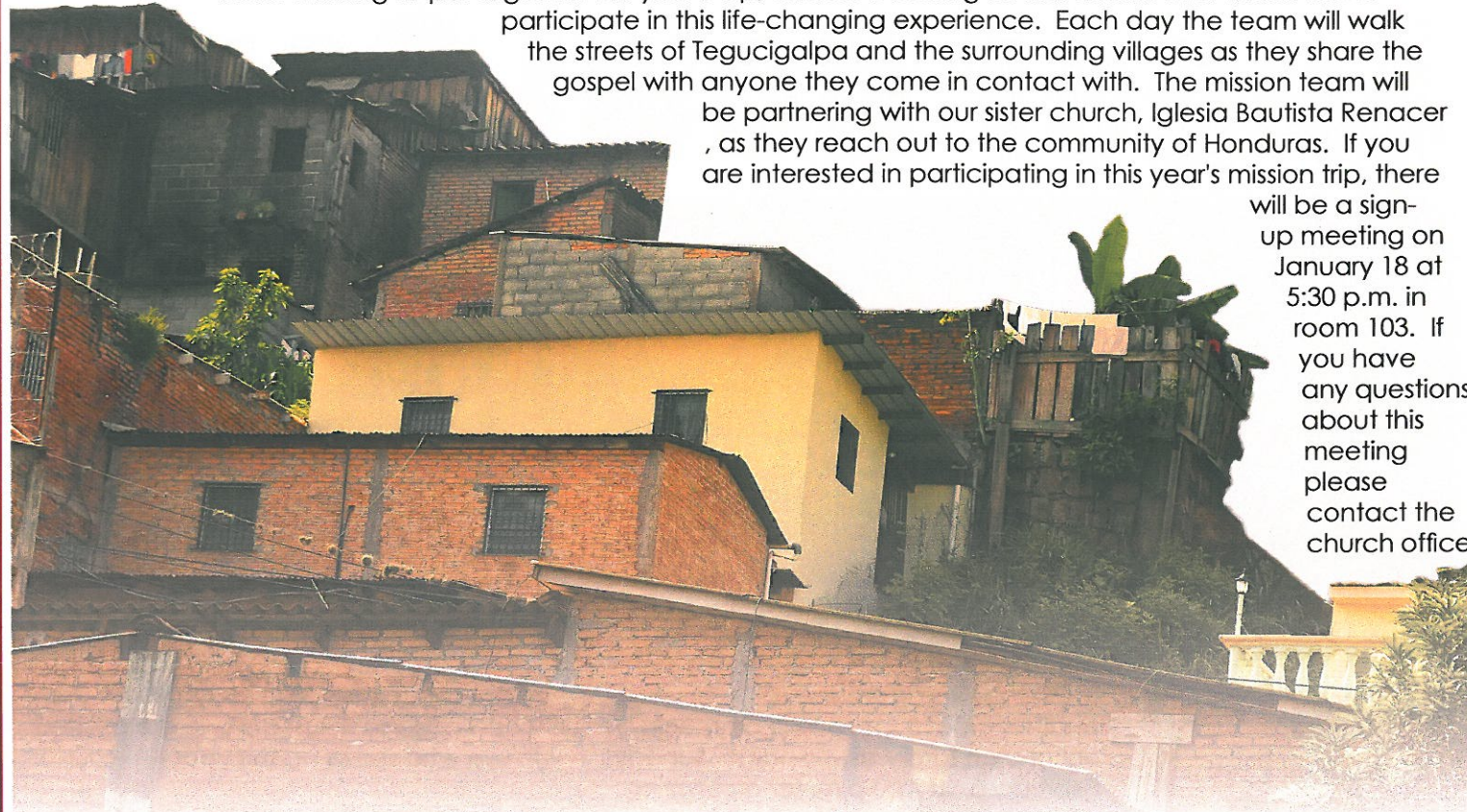


Honduras Mission Trip

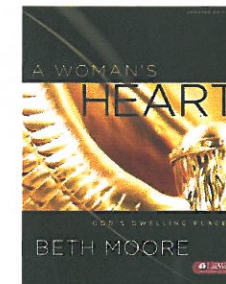
Women's Ministry
